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



















Alambique Kids


Huesca

Balnea Night


Ariño

Join and Make your own Partcharan*

Tramacastilla de Tena



This is a one-of-a-kind experience to learn all the secrets of the making of pacharán in a weekend. The experience takes place in the Tena Valley, in the heart of the Pyrenees, under the training of our Partcharan expert and accommodated at Hotel Privilegio.

The sloe berries collected and picked in the Tena Valley in October are transformed into an exquisite liqueur after macerating for six months. In April, the liqueur is filtered and transferred into chestnut barrels, where it stays for another six months before being bottled.

Fly Pirineos

Santa Cilia

Do you imagine being able to touch the peaks of the Pyrenees? This is what you experience when you take a gliding flight over the Jacetania region from the Aerodrome of Santa Cilia.

The trip is centred on the valleys of Aragon, Aisa, Aragues del Puerto, Hecho and Anso. No previous experience is required, the activity is inclusive (our planes are adapted) and it can be practised at any age.

The aerodrome of Santa Cilia has the best conditions for gliding and is a reference for gliding pilots from all over Europe. It has a pilot training school and organises hundreds of special events.





Bee Friendly

Latorrecilla



Bees are fascinating insects. In our "Bee Friendly" classroom in the heart of the Pyrenees, you get a 2-hour tour with a beekeeper to learn about the world of bees.

Photographs, explanatory panels, observation hives and a pleasant talk on beekeeping. A unique experience to get to know closely the life of these creatures essential for life.



Mushing between Vineyards


Campo de Borja Region

Take part in an active and unique experience in the art of travelling. On a sled pulled by Nordic dogs, you get to explore and discover the splendid and majestic landscapes between the vineyards of the Garnacha Route (Borja, Zaragoza).

The activity is fully accessible, and you will discover not only the richness of the landscape but also the importance of some of the crops that boost the economy of our area.

The holiday packages include a dog sled ride and different activities such as a visit to the Palace of the Counts of Bureta, meals in local restaurants, visits to wineries, night harvests, or countryside midmorning snacks.

Sierra de Albarracín Region



The sound made by a deer during the rut is always impressive and very special. If this takes place in a unique setting, Montes Universales, and with specialized guides, the experience is sure to be a success.

Perseids in the Vineyard

Which location is best suited to watch the most prolific meteor shower of the year? This was the question we had in mind at Bodegas Garbada. The answer: A place free of light and noise pollution, accessible and beautiful: our vineyard.

Guided by our expert vine-grower, we will learn how vines are grown while the sun sets behind the green fields of Cariñena. This is followed by a tasting of our wines hosted by Ignacio, the manager of our winery and after that a snack dinner will be offered.

With the use of a telescope, we will be able to observe Saturn, Jupiter, the Moon, Cassiopeia... all of this, with jazz music playing in the background.


Following 11 themed routes, you get to discover more than 50 hidden treasures that you can locate on the Prepyr 365 website and the free app Geocaching.

Feel the Cranes

Gallocanta Lagoon



Sunrise at Gallocanta Lagoon is always impressive and beautiful, regardless of the season. The experience is even more breathtaking when you can hear cranes coming out of their roost.

Your experience starts the night before with welcoming and dinner. Before dawn and in warm clothing, you follow the lead of our guide to the roosts where the show begins. The cranes wake up and begin to take flight to the soundtrack of their characteristic calls.

Flocks of cranes take off in V-shaped echelons of 20/30 birds, in total about 20,000 cranes in one morning.



Family Survival Adventure

Sierra de Loarre Region

Every year many people get lost in the mountains. These are moments when resourcefulness and instinct are essential. But what if the youngest members of the family got lost?

With our survival activities we want the whole family to have fun while learning techniques and gaining skills. Finding water, sending signals or building a small shelter can make the difference and take us a happy ending.

We work on 5 fundamental aspects of survival: Water, Fire, Shelter, Orientation and Rescue.





Vertical Dreams

Riglos



Vertical Dreams makes climbing and cliff camping more accessible to the general public, converting them into an experience within the reach of everyone.

The experience, which lasts two days and one night, starts by getting familiar with the equipment in an adventure park, at a picnic with local produce.

n the evening, we ascend the cliff: you can do it on foot or by climbing. We watch the sunset and have a Deluxe dinner. We sleep suspended on the cliff, more than 100 meters up. In the morning we have breakfast and abseil down to end the adventure in a spa.



Whispering to Vultures

Sierra de Guara Region

The activity starts in Santa Cilia, from where we move to Muladar, to have a closer contact with birds and the natural environment. The griffon vultures or Egyptian vultures will be at arm's length and we will almost be able to touch them. The icing on the cake of this experience might be the majestic flight of the bearded vulture and its orange plumage; an endangered species very frequent in the Aragonese Pyrenees and the Sierra de Guara.

After this impressive experience, we will return on foot to Santa Cilia where we will have the opportunity to visit La Casa de los Buitres, a small museum and an interpretation centre. Bring along your camera and your binoculars. A perfect activity to share with children 8+ years old!





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Dual Zip Line

Hoz de Jaca



Fun is guaranteed. All you need is a little hop to go down the pioneer dual zip line in the region of Aragon.

From the spectacular viewpoint of Hoz de Jaca and comfortably seated, the user flies for over 950 metres above the Búbal reservoir, more than 120 metres up. The zip line activity is offered 365 days a year. The jumps on nights of full moon (moonlight) or new moon (just you and the stars) from 10.30 pm to 00.30 am are even more impressive.

There is no age limit, and no special physical requirements. The age range of past participants is 9 to 92 years old.



Adapted Dual Zip Line

Fuentespalda

The magic of the Fuentespalda zipline is the feeling of flying like a bird. It is the longest double zip line in Europe with its 2 km length. The departure platform is located at Punta de la Umbría at an altitude of 1015 metres and the arrival platform is situated next to La Ermita de San Miguel at an altitude of 790 metres above sea level.

It is an authentic challenge that meets the required safety standards and has official approval. You will experience a feeling of pure adrenaline and fun; it is suitable for everyone and especially for people with reduced mobility. There is no age limit for the zip line, albeit the required minimum weight is 50 kg, and the maximum weight is 110 kg. The minimum height for children is 1.35 cm; they can take part in the activity in a tandem style, provided they meet the requirements of this style.





Trekking Mule

Huesca Pyrenees



Trekking routes of several days in the Pyrenees, spending nights at our mobile campsites in unique places, immersing yourself in nature.

Accompanied by our mules, mountain guides, biologist and cook, you will just have to think about walking, climbing peaks and contemplating the wonderful features of our mountains. We know and prepare trekking routes for all levels and ages and we provide and transport all the material. Complete breakfasts and homemade meals, perhaps camped at the foot of a high mountain lake, will be the best surprise and delight for the hiker before and after the trekking day.

Relax and let Trekking Mule guide you around the Aragonese Pyrenees.



A Day with Horses

Moscardón

An original and fun experience with horses to familiarise yourself with their behaviour in nature. The activity starts with finding the horses in the forest, fetching them and guiding them.

After receiving basic knowledge on different aspects of a horse and its behaviour, children and adults can enjoy a ride through the trails and meadows of La Sierra de Albarracín.

The activity is ideal for families, children, friends or groups who wish to enjoy the world of horses in a unique natural environment.





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Life in the Pyrenees

Sobrarbe y la Ribagorza



Explore and learn about life in the Pyrenees. The activities are aimed at children and at their parents, for them to learn and better appreciate the cultural and natural heritage of the area. There are two groups of activities: the first group is connected to the natural world ("In Search of the Bearded Vulture", "The Ethnobotanical Tour", "The Secret Life of Orchids") and the second group takes place in the rural world ("Spinning our Own Wool", "Farmer for a Day", "The Honeybees"), "Adventures in the Henhouse" and "The Secret of Janovas").

A great opportunity to awaken the interest of little ones.



Truffle Experience

Mora de Rubielos


An authentic way to get to know the world of truffles in depth. The activity has three parts: an introduction to the world of truffles, a truffle hunt and a truffle tasting.

After the introductory talk about the consumption of truffles, their different species, their uses and their aroma, we will go to the Masía El Oliva farmhouse to collect truffles. You get to witness the dog and the truffle hunter in action and then we will extract some truffles ourselves. To top it all off, the tasting of the truffles we have found takes place at Melanosporum Restaurant, with truffle menu.

This activity takes place every Saturday during the truffle season.
